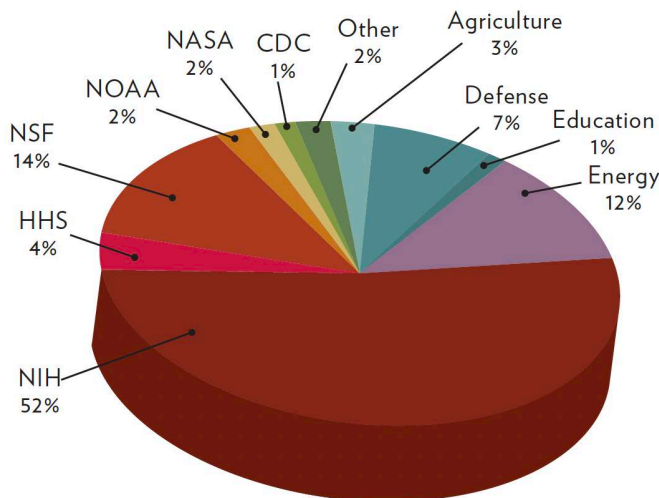




Research and Innovation at UW-Madison
