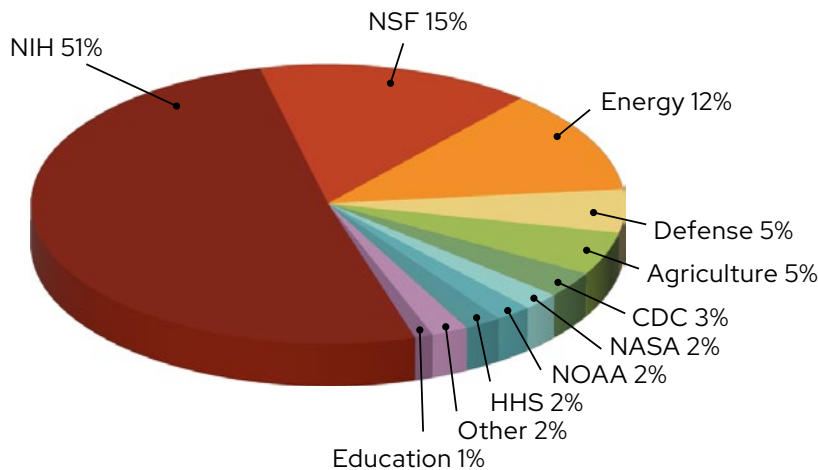




# RESEARCH AND INNOVATION AT UW-MADISON
